

PURSUIT RACE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2018 V1
TUESDAY 17th JULY

Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, the prescriptions of the RYA, the Victory Class Rules and Sailing Instructions 2018 and these Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict these Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

Variation to the Racing Rules of Sailing and Victory Class Sailing Instructions

1. Courses

The course to be sailed may be selected by the OOD from the standard Class Course Sheets or chosen from the marks listed on the Class Course Sheets as appropriate. The course details will be shown at the Haslar Signal Station by number boards or black board on the Committee Boat and broadcast on **VHF channel 15**.

2. Starting Sequence

Each boat has been issued with a number to indicate her start time in the sequence. When Number 1 is broadcast on **VHF channel 15** the boats with Number 1 will be the first boat to start, Number 2 the second boats to start etc.

Please listen out for your start sequence number

1855	Warning Signal
1856	Preparatory Signal
1859	One-minute Signal
1900	Boat's Numbered 1 in Sequence will Start (see table below)
	A sound signal for each subsequent start will be made (see table below for start times)

Boats are requested to stay out of the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark after the Warning Signal for the 1st Start until their number is displayed.

3. Individual Recall

- 3a.** When at a boat's starting signal any part of her hull, crew or equipment is viewable on the course side of the starting line a 5% penalty will be added to her elapsed time.
- 3b.** When at a boat's starting signal all her hull and transom are viewable on the course side of the starting line a 40% penalty will be added to her elapsed time.
- 3c.** No recall warning signal will be made. ***(This amends RRS Rule 29.1)***

4. Start Times are based on boat's timed finishes up to 11th July.

5. Start Sequence

(Every effort will be made to start on time but if late times will be adjusted accordingly)

6. Time Limit

The race will finish approximately 75 minutes after the first start. All boats finishing within 30 minutes of the first boat home will be timed in.

7. Finish

The finish line will be one of the following:

7.1. The Haslar Line between the mast at the Signal Station and the ODM Alfie.

7.2. Between a Committee boat displaying blue and S flags and the adjacent outer distance mark, which may be a fixed permanent mark or an inflatable mark.
