It is the Skipper's responsibility to hold emergency contact details for all crew members	
Specific attention is drawn to the below requirements:	
A sharp knife able to cut all cordage in use on your boat and able to be accessed by all crew in case of emergency	
Approved anchor as listed in the Class Rules?	
A minimum of 4.5 metres of 1/4" chain and a minimum of 20 metres of 10mm designated anchor warp	
Rescue quoit or throw line with at least 15m of line	
Two Oars (and rowlocks) or Paddles, at least 5ft long each	
Stout bucket of min 9L - not to be stowed behind water tight bulkheads if fitted	
Two Red rocket and Two Orange smoke Flares currently in date	
Approved Lifejacket or bouyancy aid (to standard ISO 12402-5 50N) for each crew member	
Necessary fittings and equipment to reef in a seamanlike manner	
Manually operated fixed bilge pump (permanently fitted to the yacht)	
Powder fire extinguisher (min 600g). State expiry date	
Working Marine VHF Radio	
Waterproof First Aid pack with instructions
