SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Set A (Sis)

Amendment One

On racing held on 31st July 2026 replace SI 9.1 with:

9.1.1 Courses will use marks listed on the Cowes Week Race Chart. The chart is published at <https://www.cowesweek.co.uk/web/download/2026/CW26-RaceChart-2.pdf>

On racing held on 31st July 2026 replace SI 20.1 with:

20.1 Only the compulsory equipment listed on the the 2026 Victory Class Racing Declaration and Safety Checklist shall be carried. Boats shall exit the harbour following the directions of KHM and not navigate in a manner that could damage the reputation of the Class.

On racing held on 31st July replace SI 14.1 with:

14.1 The finish line will be between 8G and 34.

On racing held on 31st July replace SI 7.2 with:

7.2. [NP] Every boat while racing shall carry on her backstay, either a Foxtrot or Zulu flag of which the hoist and fly shall be not less than 8" x 11" respectively.

Reasons for change:

- 1) Extend the racing areas for Cowes passage race.
- 2) Remove the need to carry an engine for the Cowes passage race.
- 3) Define the finish line for the Cowes passage race.
- 4) Allowing either F or Z flag to be used during the Cowes passage race.

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
