

Victory Class Standard Sailing Instructions 2024

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (Sis)

Amendment Two

Add:

9.1.1 An extended list of marks shall be used on racing held on 13th July 2024 and 26th July 2024. The extended list is shown on the Cowes Week 2023 race chart that will be published on the official notice board. The mark “Nab Tower, 6R” may also be used.

The names of marks may have been changed the alphanumeric code should be used when referring to these marks.

SI 20.1 is replaced with:

20.1 In addition to the compulsory equipment listed on the 2024 Victory Class Racing Declaration and Safety Checklist, boats shall carry for all races covered by these sailing instructions, a functional engine and sufficient ‘fuel’ (to include battery capacity in the case of an electric engine) to complete 2 transits of Portsmouth Harbour entrance under power in the tidal conditions expected on the day of the race (regardless of whether such transits need to be made under power).

On racing held on 26th July 2024 replace SI 20.1 with:

20.1 Only the compulsory equipment listed on the the 2024 Victory Class Racing Declaration and Safety Checklist shall be carried. Boats shall exit the harbour following the directions of KHM and not navigate in a manner that could damage the reputation of the Class.

Reasons for change:

- 1) Extend the racing areas for specific races
- 2) Fix a typo, “2023” replaced with “2024”
- 3) Remove the need to carry an engine for the Cowes passage race.
