SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Set "A" (SIs)

Amendment One

SI 9 is replaced with:

9. COURSES

- 9.1. Courses will use marks listed on the Victory Class Racing Mark Chartlet and the Victory Class Harbour Chart.
- 9.2. Courses will be displayed on the back of a committee vessel. If a committee vessel is not used, then course information will be passed to competitors by VHF radio
- 9.3. All marks are to be turning marks unless otherwise indicated.
- 9.4. *Not Used*
- 9.4.1. *Not Used*
- 9.4.2. *Not Used*
- 9.5. [NP] When racing in the area shown on the Victory Class Racing Mark Chartlet, boats shall not:
 - 9.5.1. Be North and East of a line from BC Outer to No.4
 - 9.5.2. Be North and East of a line from No. 4 to No.2
- 9.6. When racing in the area shown on the Victory Class Harbour Chart, boats shall not:
 - 9.6.1. Pass any channel piles on the shallow water side, except when used as a turning mark.

Reasons for Change:

- 1) Following recommendations from a protest committee, courses should be displayed in full on the committee vessel and course cards should not be used from a committee vessel.

SI 20.1 is replaced with:

- 20.1. In addition to the compulsory equipment listed on the 2025 Victory Class Racing Declaration and Safety Checklist Version 2, boats shall carry for all races covered by these sailing instructions:
